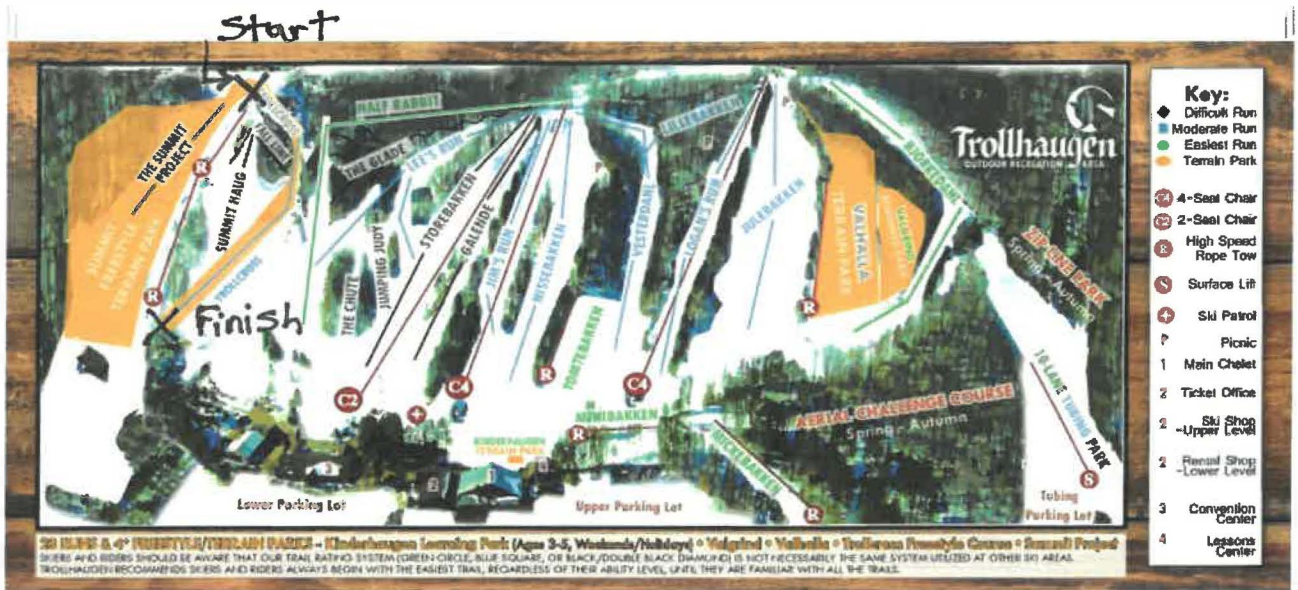


**Welcome Athletes, Coaches & Families to the

All Start Times Are Approximate

Groups should meet at the bottom of the course at their start time and remain at the course until their group heat is finished

Group 1 Heat – 10:30 start time. (practice prior to start time)

All Twin Tips - All Ages - Boys & Girls

Group 2 Heat – 12:00 (Noon) start time. (practice to follow finals for group 1 heat)

SB Boys – all boys ages 11 and under

(8 & Under, 9, 10, 11)

SB Girls – all ages

Group 3 Heat – 1:45 start time. (practice to follow finals for group 2 heat)

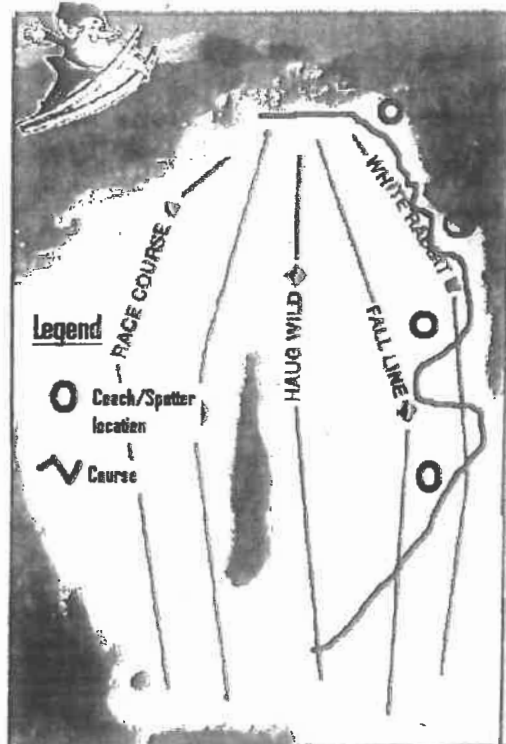
SB Boys – all boys ages 12 and up

(12, 13, 14, 15+)

**ALL AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN ON-SNOW AT THE COURSE
AT THE END OF THE FINAL RACE FOR EACH GROUP
HEAT.**

Boardercross / Skiercross Event Information

- All age group heats will be run through finals.
- **Awards will be presented on-snow at the race site after finals for each group.**
- Age groups less than 6 will run 3 races, with points awarded each race to determine overall winner.
- Age groups with more than 6 will be run as double elimination. If a rider / skier continues to place 1st or 2nd (except wild card round) they will continue to advance forward.
- **ONLY ONE RIDER ADVANCES IN WILD CARD RACE**
- All heat start times are approximate, based on the number of participants that register.
- All athletes will run at least 2 races minimum.
- **Athletes**, please be at the designated waiting area at the bottom of the hill by the time your group is scheduled to start.
- All athletes for each age group will be required to stay in the designated corral area until their age group is done racing.
- Athletes will be called out of the corral area by bib number, and a coach will bring you to the top of the race course when it is time to compete. After you race, return to the corral until called again.
- **If an athlete misses a race heat, it will be recorded as a loss.**
- Athletes must go around or through any marked gates on the course. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- Minor contact is expected to happen; however, any Pushing, Shoving, Kicking, Hitting, or deliberate contact is not allowed, and will lead to disqualification. Disqualification is up to the course official's discretion.
- **Spectators** – there are several viewing areas available throughout the course. Please remember to keep yourself and the athletes safe by staying off the course. If you have questions on where to view the race from, please find a Trollhaugen Coach. (Orange coats / hoodies.)
- If you have any questions, please ask a Trollhaugen Coach for assistance.



TROLLHAUGEN COMPETITION RELEASE OF LIABILITY 2019

**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING.
THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS.**

Of my own free will, I agree to enter and compete in the BOARDER/SKIER CROSS competition at Trollhaugen under the terms contained hereinafter.

I understand that snowboarding/skiing and this competition involve risks, dangers, and hazards that may cause serious personal injury or death and that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence in this sport and in competition. Risks include, but are not limited to, falls, changes in terrain, weather and snow surfaces, ice, bare spots, debris, fences, posts, signs, snowmaking and grooming operations and equipment, snowmobile operations, padded and non-padded barriers, collisions with other persons, and other natural and man-made hazards. I freely accept and assume the risks associated with snowboarding/skiing and this competition.

I represent I possess the necessary skills and physical ability to compete in this competition in such a manner that I will not endanger myself, other competitors, spectators or other persons. I understand that as a snowboarder/skier, I am bound by certain Wisconsin state laws and the Skier Responsibility Code (known as Your Responsibility Code). I understand it is my responsibility to inspect the terrain features and their associated terrain, including their approaches and the angle and length of the take-off ramps and landing areas, prior to competing to avoid falls and collisions and to avoid injury to myself and others. I understand I am responsible for inspection and maintenance of my equipment. I agree to use restraint devices and/or leashes at all times. I further understand inverted aerial maneuvers are NOT allowed.

In consideration of the permission to compete in the BOARDER/SKIER competition at Trollhaugen and use its facilities, **I HEREBY RELEASE AND FULLY DISCHARGE Trollhaugen, its owners, officers, shareholders, agents or employees (collectively the "TROLLHAUGEN RELEASEES") from any liability resulting from any personal injury to myself, including death, or damage to my property which is caused by the BREACH OF ANY EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTY or the NEGLIGENCE ACT OR OMISSION of any TROLLHAUGEN RELEASEE, including any NEGLIGENCE ACT OR OMISSION in:**

- the preparation, organization, coordination, judging, operation, or supervision of the competition;
- the preparation, design, location, construction, inspection, maintenance, or repair of terrain features, including rails and boxes;
- instructions given or not given to me concerning the competition, the terrain features and their associated terrain, or any part thereof;
- the design, location, construction, inspection, and maintenance of table tops and other jumps, including their approaches and the angle and length of the take-off ramps and landing areas;
- grooming, snowmaking, the operation of chairlifts and surface lifts, and chairlift and surface lift loading and unloading operations for the competition;
- padding or non-padding of natural and man-made obstacles and hazards; or
- posting or failure to post warnings, signs, fences, or other cautions or barriers, and the construction of or non-construction of fences and other barriers, including the selection of the construction materials.

I accept full responsibility for any personal injury or damage which may result from my participation in the BOARDER/SKIER CROSS competition, and I hereby **HOLD HARMLESS** the TROLLHAUGEN RELEASEES for any personal injury or damage sustained by me, including death, while participating in this competition. I agree not to bring any action or lawsuit against any TROLLHAUGEN RELEASEE for any personal injury or damage.

In accordance with Wisconsin law, nothing in this Release of Liability should be construed as releasing, discharging or waiving any claims I may have for reckless or intentional acts on the part of any TROLLHAUGEN RELEASEE.

I understand that, for a fee of \$20.00 in addition to the normal entry fee, Trollhaugen offers an optional Competition Agreement that does not require me to sign a release of liability. In signing this Release of Liability, I acknowledge I am aware of this option offered by Trollhaugen and hereby waive my right to purchase the same.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS COMPETITION RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS COMPETITION RELEASE OF LIABILITY, I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE TROLLHAUGEN, ITS OWNERS, OFFICERS, SHAREHOLDERS, AGENTS OR EMPLOYEES FOR CERTAIN CLAIMS.
