



2019 – 2020 Weekday Field Trip

BUCK HILL

Program:

- Lift ticket, ski rental, helmet rental and a beginner lesson
Snowboard lessons and rental not included.
- Groups of 200 or more students are encouraged to come in 2 shifts about 20 – 30 minutes apart. This allows for a smoother flow through the rental shop.

Billing:

- Final participation numbers must be provided, and invoice will be issued (7 days) prior to visit.
- Invoices will be emailed to address indicated on the reservation confirmation.
- Payments must be paid no later than the day of your visit.

Chaperones/Teacher Requirements:

- One (1) complimentary chaperone ticket is provided per 10 paid students.
- Extra chaperones are welcomed and will be charged the same rate as the students; \$18.
- The group coordinator must provide adequate supervision for their group while at Buck Hill
- One chaperone must remain in the chalet at all times.
- Chaperones must assist in making sure the students keep the chalet clean and behave in an appropriate manner.
- Chaperones need to assist the students in the rental shop getting on their boots.
- Skiing chaperones need to help monitor students on the slopes to ensure they are skiing on terrain appropriate for their level of ability.

Lift Tickets:

- Tickets will be distributed during the presentation in the main chalet on the day of your visit.
- Participants with a Buck Hill season pass are not required to purchase the \$18 package but should bring their pass on the day of the event to obtain a lift ticket in the ticket office.
- Participants may stay and continue to ski/ride after group leaves; lift ticket is valid all day.

Rental:

- Rental forms will be mailed to your school prior to your visit; a completed sample included
- A parent signature is needed on the forms.
- Any unused rental forms must be returned on the last visitation day.
- Ski Poles will not be distributed to students renting equipment regardless of ability level.
- Helmets are included in the field trip price.
- *Snowboard Rental & Lessons not included.* For participants bringing their own snowboards, boards must have metal edges, a full binding, and a leash.

Lessons:

- Station taught format taking roughly 60 to 90 minutes to complete.
- All participants, including skiers and snowboarders with their own equipment, are required to pass the Chairlift station before being able to go ski/ride on their own.
- If the Chairlift station is not passed, students are required to remain on the runs serviced by the carpets.
- All Mountain Access station is only for those skiers/riders with advanced skills. This will allow skiers/riders to use all the chair lifts and terrain at the area.
