2023 – 2024 After School Ski & Snowboard Club *(Grades 4 – 12)*

Reservations:

- Date(s) of visitations will be requested through the online Reservation Request Form [2023-2024 After School Club Reservation Request Form](#)
- Link(s) for participants to pre-purchase lift tickets, rental and lessons will be set-up and provided to the Group Coordinator for distribution to participants/parents
- All purchases will be made online and in advance
- Make-up dates would only be for an entire group to use should a scheduled date need to be cancelled

Lift Tickets:

- All lift tickets will be pre-purchased online a minimum of 48 hours prior to arrival
- Tickets will be printed and available for the Group Coordinator to pick up upon arrival from the ticket office.
- All participant lift ticket must be picked up from the coordinator.

Rental:

- Rental equipment must be pre-purchased online.
- Rental forms will be available for the coordinator to pick-up and pass out to renters in the group
- Replacement rental forms must go through the coordinator.
- The following information should be indicated on the Rental Form:
 - Renters Contact Info
 - Height
 - Weight
 - SKIER TYPE
Type 1 = cautious Type 2 = moderate Type 3 = aggressive
 - SNOWBOARDING
Regular (*left foot forward*) Goofy (*right foot forward*)

Lessons:

- **Beginner** station taught lesson is included with the lift ticket purchase; should your group visit multiple weeks, a lesson will *only* be available the first two weeks
- Lessons will begin 15 minutes after your groups arrival time and run no later than 6:00PM
- All lessons will launch from the Lesson Meeting Area (white flag outside of Rental)

Chaperones/Teacher Requirements:

- One (1) complimentary chaperone ticket is provided per 10 paid students.
- The group coordinator must provide adequate supervision for their group while at Buck Hill
- The Lead Chaperone onsite must provide the ticket office and Ski Patrol their contact phone
- Skiing/Snowboarding chaperones need to help monitor students on the slopes to ensure they are skiing/riding on terrain appropriate for their level of ability.
- Chaperones must assist in making sure the students keep the chalet clean and behave in an appropriate manner.

Chalet:

- Group will have one assigned table in Hillside.
- One chaperone must remain in the chalet at all times.
- No outside food and beverage are permitted in our buildings. Full-service food available for purchase
- Rearranging and moving tables will not be allowed.
- We request that all personal items be left in a vehicle, on the bus or put in a locker.
- *Hutch Chalet rental based on availability and additional fees apply*

2023 – 2024 Buck Hill Group Rates

Weekday Field Trips – Grades 4 – 12

Bring your 4th to 12th Grade class to Buck Hill to experience an outdoor winter field trip that will build skills and confidence as they learn to safely ski. Students will be taught by our Ski School through learning stations, at their own pace, until they can safely navigate the slopes with controlled turns and stops. Experienced students may ski independently after demonstrating their ability.

Program includes Lift ticket, ski rental with helmet and a beginner ski lesson. Field trips are offered Monday through Friday mornings throughout the season, excluding holidays. Advanced reservation required and based on availability.

- **One (1) complimentary chaperone ticket is provided per 10 student participants.**
- **The number of student participants must be confirmed one week (7 days) prior to visit.**

After School Ski & Snowboard Clubs: 4 – 12th Grade

School groups (4-12) with 20 or more students can receive discounted lift tickets and rental equipment for their after-school ski and snowboard clubs. Advanced reservations required a minimum of 14 days prior to the visit and based on availability.
