# 2023 – 2024 Weekday Field Trip

*Grades 4 - 12*

## Reservations:

- Date(s) of visitations will be requested through the online Reservation Request Form [2023-2024 Weekday Field Trip Reservation Request Form](#)

## Program:

- Lift ticket, ski rental, helmet rental and a beginner lesson  
*Snowboard lessons and rental not included.*
- Class can arrive as early as 9:00am
- Program runs Monday through Friday from 10am – 4pm, except during holidays

## Liability Release:

- A liability form must be completed by each parent for their student

## Lift Tickets:

- Final participation numbers are required 48 hours prior
- Lift Tickets will be distributed by our Ski School upon arrival
- Participants with a Buck Hill season pass are not required to purchase the \$21 package; passholders must bring their pass on the day of the event to obtain a lift ticket in the ticket office.

## Rental:

- Rental forms will be mailed, or dropped off to your school prior to your visit; a completed sample included
- A parent signature is needed on the forms.
- Any unused rental forms must be returned on the last visitation day.
- Ski Poles will not be distributed to students renting equipment regardless of ability level.
- Helmets are required and included in the field trip price.
- *Snowboard Rental & Lessons not included.* For participants bringing their own snowboards, boards must have metal edges, a full binding, and a leash.

## Lessons:

- Station taught format taking roughly 60 to 90 minutes to complete; ending by noon.
- All participants, including skiers and snowboarders with their own equipment, are required to pass the Chairlift station before being able to go ski/ride on their own.
- If the Chairlift station is not passed, students are required to remain on the runs serviced by the carpets.
- All Mountain Access station is only for those skiers/riders with advanced skills. This will allow skiers/riders to use all the chair lifts and terrain at the area.

## Chaperones/Teacher Requirements:

- One (1) complimentary chaperone ticket is provided per 10 paid students.
- Extra chaperones are welcomed and will be charged the same rate as the students; \$21.
- The group coordinator must provide adequate supervision for their group while at Buck Hill
- One chaperone must remain in the chalet at all times.
- Chaperones must assist in making sure the students keep the chalet clean and behave in an appropriate manner.
- Chaperones need to assist the students in the rental shop getting on their boots.
- Skiing chaperones need to help monitor students on the slopes to ensure they are skiing on terrain appropriate for their level of ability.
- **No outside food and beverage is allowed in our Main Chalet.** Should your group be bringing a bag lunch, please inform the Buck Hill Group Coordinator prior to arrange an additional space for your group.

# 2023 – 2024 Buck Hill Group Rates

## Weekday Field Trips – Grades 4 – 12

Bring your 4<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Grade class to Buck Hill to experience an outdoor winter field trip that will build skills and confidence as they learn to safely ski. Students will be taught by our Ski School through learning stations, at their own pace, until they can safely navigate the slopes with controlled turns and stops. Experienced students may ski independently after demonstrating their ability.

**Program includes Lift ticket, ski rental with helmet and a beginner ski lesson.** Field trips are offered Monday through Friday mornings throughout the season, excluding holidays. Advanced reservation required and based on availability.

- **One (1) complimentary chaperone ticket is provided per 10 student participants.**
- **The number of student participants must be confirmed one week (7 days) prior to visit.**

## After School Ski & Snowboard Clubs: 4 – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade

School groups (4-12) with 20 or more students can receive discounted lift tickets and rental equipment for their after-school ski and snowboard clubs. Advanced reservations required a minimum of 14 days prior to the visit and based on availability.

Gather your friends, family, scouts, youth group, etc. of 20 or more participants and receive discounted lift tickets when you pre-book your visit a minimum 14 days prior to the visit and based on availability. All purchases must be made online prior to arrival.
